Welcome/Public Comment	Meeting called to order 5:06pm		
Recreation Fields Visioning	Discussion: A couple of items were missing from the document including a Gaga pit, adult fitness stations, bike racks for the field, and adding "drainage assessment" to the surveying of the land. Moving forward with the plan, would be ideal to add in demographic data to the "rationale" section including poverty and health-related data to best justify the need for enhanced recreation in the community. It will also make grant-writing better. As far as priorities, ECRC agreed that maintenance of existing resources is a priority and also more feasible. Adding in resources, such as a play structure, trees, and lighting, would likely have to wait until a physical plan of the space is completed so as not to have to move anything. Looks like RiseVT is able to help pay for signage, both at the entrance to the fields, and with messaging around the gravel walking path. Since the playstructure would likely not be able to be paid for in its entirety or placed this summer, a RiseVT grant for \$5000 doesn't make sense for this year (funds would have to be spent this calendar year) but if we looked for funding for a bigger portion of the structure (like Kaboom!), then RiseVT funding could be applied for next year for a match/contribution.	Amy will edit and resend planning document by Monday morning. Amy will communicate with Stacy/Denise Smith of RiseVT to communicate back to them about our playstructure ideas to see if the minigrant could be used differently. Ivonne will talk to Billie Jo about how much the path cost originally to be built, and who built it. Amy (and anyone else) will investigate the cost of the path refresh vs. gaga pit + pickleball needs and communicate with RiseVT about changes. Shawna will ask Selectboard on Monday whether they can receive the bike racks for the Rec Fields. Amy/Shawna will follow up with Greta about how this matches with the Better Connections proposed work by the consultant.
