Town of Enosburgh Selectboard meeting, present were Polly Rico, Larry Gervais, Pierre Letourneau, Billie Jo Draper, Robert Gleason.

Change of agenda items, Joey Clark at 6:15 and fire hose discussion at 6:50, motion by Polly Rico, seconded by Pierre Letourneau, all in favor, so moved.

Motion to approve minutes from the last meeting by Pierre Letourneau, seconded by Polly Rico, all in favor, so moved.

Robert Gleason came in to discuss the ambulance service, this year's budget has a line item for cardiac monitors in it, and we need them sooner than later. Motion to allow Robert to purchase the cardiac monitors, by Polly Rico, seconded by Pierre Letourneau, all in favor, so moved.

Joey Clark came in to inform the board that the truck that is in need of replacing has had recent large repair cost, with a new motor and walking beams, and brakes.

Joey also discussed the hazard mitigation project at Philip Robtoy's, and right now it seems that it's in the hands of Northwest Regional Planning with the emergency management plan.

Daryl Robtoy came in about the town website and discussion about what is new and should go on it. Lots of good ideas were tossed around, and Daryl will get started on some new items.

Purchase of some new hose for the fire department came before the board, Mark LaRose fire chief came in to say they came across a deal for 5,000 feet of 5" hose for \$6,000.00. Motion by Polly Rico, seconded by Larry Fiske, all in favor, so moved.

The selectboard contacted Terry Wright by phone and informed him of happenings of the month so far, as he is away in Florida, he was appreciative of the phone call and being kept informed.

Dollar General sent in a representative from their law firm to make sure that the liquor license that they have applied for gets signatures. They are applying for the first time in Vermont. The Enosburgh Selectboard signed the license application for beer and wine.

Orders and licenses were signed.
