Next on agenda was Riley Bockus and Larry Benoit, who are neighbors with complaints. Riley is upset with the animals being loose. Larry Benoit feels that he is being harassed. Larry Gervais tried to keep order and reminded them the camera was rolling, and that it is up to Larry Benoit to keep his fence up. He disputes the fact that the fence is his problem, he states that the highway department took it down 5 years ago and it's up to them to put it back. Polly Rico stated that this has happened too much and perhaps we will impound the animals, she asked that Larry understand Riley's side of it that he does not want his property destroyed. Larry Gervais addressed Riley and asked do you share a border fence, Riley said no. Larry asked how are the cows accessing your yard Riley? Larry asked that they both be responsible for the fence line. Timothy Bockus spoke and said Larry needs to keep a proper fence. Larry maintains that it's the town's fault the fence is down. Larry Gervais and Polly Rico suggested he put into his sugar woods contract that the lessee close the gates. He thought that was a good suggestion. Tim Bockus spoke to Riley trying to improve his land and not have a problem with his mound system and keeping the animals off will be a help. Riley asked for a date deadline for this issue to be resolved. Pierre Letourneau suggested one week to put the gate up, then the fence May 20, and a report to us by the 21st of May.
