Town of Enosburgh Selectboard meeting, present were Polly Rico, Pierre Letourneau, Terry Wright, Larry Fiske, Larry Gervais, Joey Clark, Billie Jo Draper.

Minutes were read and approved, with a motion by Polly Rico, seconded by Larry Fiske, all in favor, so moved.

First on the agenda was Stacey Carpenter, Mary Bickner, they are public health nurses with a focus on disease and are concerned about used needles. She has investigated the situation and there is a company that will give a lock box for just such things and has had conversations with Robert Gleason at the ambulance service and he is on board and feels it's a good idea. Needles are not easy to dispose of and this type of disposal would not cost the town anything. Lots of ideas were tossed around and the board will think about it.

Joey Clark came in to talk about a problem with a car that had a problem on the Chester Arthur Road. The board decided that it would be best to contact the insurance company on this.

Dave Mahoney from Vermont Connections came in for proposal on phone system for the town office and library. Selectboard had a lot of questions and cost saving thoughts, and would like to look into this more.

Will & Victor Veve came in about the solar project at the Leach Gravel Pit. Net metered solar project, it has been set by state and the owner can sell back the credits produced. They will have excess credits to sell, the school is also a potential buyer of credits. The planning commission will meet with them in July. They are answering comments from ANR and the public service board currently. In about 40 days they will file their complete petition. They will be offering the town the chance to save roughly 10% (\$2,500.00) per year. Warranty is 20 years and that is how long the contract will be.

Loan papers for the new tandem truck were reviewed and signed, motion by Polly Rico, seconded by Pierre Letourneau to approve this action with Community National Bank, all in favor, so moved.
