Present were Terry Wright, Pierre Letourneau, Larry Fiske, Larry Gervais, Vaughn Commeau, Billie Jo Draper.

Motion to adjust the agenda for Mark LaRose at 6:00 and Joey Clark at 8:30.

Minutes from June 15, 2015 were read. Motion to approve by Pierre Letourneau, seconded by Terry Wright, all in favor so moved.

Mark LaRose came in to discuss a few fire department, one was mutual aid agreement which needed clarification on why it was received. Next he wanted to talk about a truck replacement – they have been to Springfield, Massachusetts to view several vehicles at a show. There are several promising vendors. Last thing was about computers in the fire and ambulance building, just wanted to know if we were going to update computer system any time soon.

7:00 Motion to go into executive session for personnel issues, this was made by Pierre Letourneau, seconded by Larry Fiske, so moved.

8:00 Terry Wright made motion to come out of executive and seconded by Pierre Letourneau, all in favor so moved.

OTHER BUSINESS

8:05 Dean & Pamela Scott came in to talk to the board about the problems with training hours. Dean asked what the allegations were. Pam is accused of falsifying of documents, she said that is totally untrue. She is a registered nurse and claims that she gets more hours than needed.

Dean gave a brief rundown of a time line of recent events. Explained that he believes Richard does not have to sign Pam's papers, she can have a district person do it. He said that Jim Lyden from the state cleared him and Pam, however the attorney for the town clarified by saying that Mr. Lyden informed him there is an ongoing investigation. On the subject of him firing Richard Page he said he had the power, however the town's attorney clarified to him that he did not have the authority only the selectboard does. The board stated they had a lot of information to review and would be in touch but that they both are still on paid administrative leave.

Motion to go back in to executive session by Larry Fiske and seconded by Terry Wright, all in favor.

Motion to come out of executive session by Terry Wright, and seconded by Pierre Letourneau, all in favor.

Due to discussion in executive session a motion was made to have Bauer, Gravel and Farnham to do an investigation of all allegations against the Scotts. Motion by Pierre Letourneau, and seconded by Larry Fiske, all in favor, so moved.

Joey Clark came in to discuss highway business, first on his list was a driveway permit for Anthony & Kim Nichols. He will tell them 15" culvert and to see zoning administrator for further direction.

Paving prices were presented to be done on Tyler Branch by Vaillancourts Garage to the corner, and by the Methodist church on Tyler Branch and Bogue Road and maybe St. Pierre and Chester Arthur Road, these would just be aprons, as we did not receive a grant this year, the estimates are what we have in the paving budget.

Last on Joey's list was the mitigation update, he told the board the he had spoken to Ray Doherty, it's in FEMA's hands and under review. Larry Fiske asked for copies of all of Joey's papers.

Discussion ensued next on a tentative date for the town's barbecue, August 15, 2015 was selected and will be checked on with the Dairy Center.
