<p>Rec Fields Revitalization Plan Project</p>	<p>Grant was for \$21,700. To date, spent \$20,759</p> <p>All that we have left to do is to present to the Selectboard. The project is a long-term plan that could be phased in and paid for over time. Selectboard meetings are 1st/3rd Mondays of the month usually. Ivonne' wages: become salaried with a max of \$20,000, which is \$19/hour @ 20 hours/week. In 2019, Ivonne put in more hours, which translated into more accomplished.
