Town of Enosburgh Selectboard meeting

Present by Zoom were Larry Gervais, Polly Rico, Dean Wright, Pierre Letourneau, Philip Robtoy, Joey Clark, Sean Kio and Billie Jo Draper.

Cindy Weed president of the Enosburgh Historical Society was first on the agenda. She discussed the need to replace the roof at the freight station. She asked that the board consider a line item to help with this. The discussion ensued in regard to ownership of the building and the price as well as grants that might help this.

Motion by Polly Rico, second by Dean Wright, to approve Ivonne Kio's request that she go on unpaid leave rather than the family leave act for her maternity leave. All in favor, so moved.

Snow removal at the armory after the contractors moved out was discussed, and it was decided that it be done as needed basis for this winter. Robtoy Property Care will do this as they were the only ones submitted a requested bid at \$40.00 per time, motion by Pierre Letourneau, second by Dean Wright, all in favor, so moved.

Discussion on the armory took place with a decision to meet to look over the property on January 9<sup>th</sup> at 1:00, clerk was instructed to warn this meeting.

Motion by Polly Rico to go into executive session at 6:45, second by Dean Wright, all in favor, so moved.

Discussion ensued on the town meeting for 2021 and options. Decision was made to do Australian Ballot and have informational meeting on March 1 by zoom. Voting will be at the fire station from 10-2 on March 2.
