Town of Enosburgh Selectboard meeting, present were Polly Rico, Terry Wright, Larry Gervais, and Billie Jo Draper.

Item added to agenda by motion from Polly Rico for bridge discussion by Wrights, second by Terry Wright, all in favor, so moved.

Motion to approve the May 13, 2019 minutes by Polly Rico, second by Terry Wright, all in favor, so moved.

On the agenda we have ambulance discussion with Scott Flieger and Robert Gleason. Richford is having difficulty with staffing their ambulance. Josh Aldrich stated through an email to Scott Flieger that as of June 1, 2019 they do not have coverage on weekends, they have no written contracts with MVR or AmCare or Enosburgh Ambulance. The State of Vermont is aware as well as our local district representatives. Mutual Aid is when no money exchanges hand and we help each other. This situation is not mutual aid as they can't staff their ambulances. They have contacted our selectboard and they have suggested that Enosburgh give them a price for weekend coverage. This means Richford has no Advanced EMT on their staff on a typical day.

Motion by Polly Rico to go into executive session and second by Terry Wright, all in favor, so moved at 6:35.

Motion to approve the purchase of 8 ambulance jackets by Polly Rico, second by Terry Wright, all in favor, so moved.

The 911 box at the ambulance station needs repair, motion to repair by Polly Rico, second by Terry Wright, all in favor, so moved.

Terry Wright made the motion to purchase the Active 911 app for the service, second by Polly Rico, all in favor, so moved.

Motion to come out of executive session by Terry Wright, second by Polly Rico at 7:00, all in favor, so moved.

Pierre Letourneau entered the meeting at 6:55.

Joey Clark road foreman came in for bid paving opening. Representatives from Pike and Hutchins came in for this. Paving will be for Duffy Hill and Perley Road overlay and two sections on Boston Post Road.

Pike \$67.70 Whitcomb \$73.00 Hutchins \$68.75 price per ton, no second.

Motion by Polly Rico to go with Pike, second by Terry Wright, all in favor, so moved.

Grant agreement for the Perley Road paving project was presented and signed.

Discussion on the bridge on Horseshoe Circle was done.

Mark LaRose came in for gear discussion to update the fire department. Polly Rico made the motion to go with HSE fire gear, all in favor, so moved.
