Town of Enosburgh Selectboard meeting, present were Terry Wright, Polly Rico, Larry Gervais, Pierre Letourneau, Joey Clark

Minutes from July 1, 2019 were read and approved with a motion by Pierre Letourneau, second by Polly Rico, all in favor, so moved.

Pierre Letourneau explained the situation with the bid for the Opera House and the higher bid for painting, mostly it was for the repairs to the window such as caulking and rotten boards. Tabled for later.

Two members from the Sheldon board came to discuss the Duffy Hill paving project. They are not comfortable paying the approximate \$44,000 for any Enosburgh paving as its not half and half. Maps were viewed and discussion took place. They suggested to wait a year or so and come up with a plan to do both ends together. Their members left at 6:33. It was decided that even though part of the road is Sheldon it will get paved this year and paid by Town of Enosburgh Highway District.

Plans for the sand/salt shed were presented along with papers for amended contracts. Discussion about many items including, footing, rafters and pillars.

Motion to sign the zoning application for the project by Polly Rico, second by Terry Wright, all in favor, so moved.

Bridge #50 was discussed and the needed repairs.

The new roads and bridge standards were presented and approved with a motion from Polly Rico, second by Pierre Letourneau, all in favor, so moved. Joey left the meeting at 8:00.

Sean Kio came for an update on the Technology and Innovation Committee. Things are slow he stated, membership is up and down, he wanted to tell the board about the survey results.

Scott Flieger came in for update with Richford contract. He will make needed changes and send to Richford for signatures.

Repairs to the ambulances were discussed.
