Larry stated we left a lot of money on the table not going with International that he feels they should take the truck as is. Shawna Lovelette and Luke Willey came in about the wet fields at the Dairy Center they were joined with Lise Gates owner of the fields. She stated that if we fixed the wet fields that maybe she would forego the fee for two years.

Tim Stetson and Elizabeth Malone from NW Access came in. Larry Gervais outlined the reasons that this request be an appropriation and not an expense. Discussion ensued about the timeline due for the petition.
